Meeting called to discuss Council's strategy and plan for the Persimmon Development at Nova Scotia Farm, West Caister and to provide a statement for the Village.

After a lengthy discussion it was proposed by Cllr. K Wood, seconded by Cllr. P Sleet and agreed by all members present that the following statement be provided for the Parishioners of Caister.

CAISTER PARISH COUNCIL IS OPPOSED TO THE MAGNOLIA GARDENS DEVELOPMENT

WHY: The Council opposes the development because of the effect on:

Infrastructure: Including roads which will become overcrowded and logjammed with vehicles requiring a new bypass to replace the one downgraded by the development, and road safety. Children travelling to and from school is a major concern. Crossing Jack Chase Way to get to and from the schools will be a hazard for children of all ages

Environment: Including the destruction of hedgerows, trees and the disturbance of wildlife breeding grounds and the loss of grade A Agricultural land. The concreting

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over of swathes of grade A Agricultural land with its trees fauna and natural drainage system.

Facilities & Utilities: There will be no medical or dental facilities in the new development. The development will be totally dependent on schools in our village and the additional population will threaten our village being turned into a suburb of Great Yarmouth, resulting in the loss of our unique village identity. Can the utilities provide the required level of support for this conurbation?
