43 DECLARATION OF INTEREST

44 ACCOUNTS

Clerk presented copies of the Quarterly Reconciliation and Income & Expenditure reports to 31st March 2022 for approval.

It was proposed by Cllr. P Sleet, seconded by Cllr. R Wilkinson, agreed by all members present that accounts be approved: **recommend Council accepts proposal**

45 FIREPROOF SAFE

Clerk reported that a fireproof safe was required to store the Cemetery books in, this is a legal requirement of under the Local Authorities' Cemeteries Order 1977. A large safe was required with internal dimensions of at least $16" \times 20" \times 16"$. After discussion it was proposed by Cllr. A Baker, seconded by Cllr. R Wilkinson and agreed by all members present that Clerk obtains prices of large fireproof safes up to £1,500 + VAT: recommend Council agrees to the above
