YOU SAID, WE DID

Another 'Alcohol Awareness Week' was held in November as part of our Community Alcohol Partnership. Pop-up events took place throughout Great Yarmouth and Gorleston, where officers and colleagues from partner organisations spoke to students in schools, and to parents of young people, surveying members of the public and offlicences about consumption and the laws around alcohol. Alcohol cans were also tagged with UV pens by our police cadets in an effort to track and curb the sale of alcohol to young people.

High visibility foot and mobile patrols have been taking place in the rural Flegg villages, along with school visits and public engagement events. Contact has also been made with businesses in key tourist spots and local shops, as well as Filby Hall children's home.

In Caister and the coastal villages, the Beat Manager has been making regular patrols on the Allendale and Caister High Street, and has held meetings at The Rabbit Hutch, with visits to local schools.

In North Yarmouth we've been targeting antisocial behaviour, particularly in the Newtown area. Joint visits took place for both North and South Yarmouth at Hawkins Close, Keyes Avenue, Midland Close and to local shops in the lead up to Halloween, to provide reassurance and guidance to retailers.

In Great Yarmouth town centre regular patrols have been conducted through St George's Park, and key areas where antisocial behaviour has been reported, with alcohol confiscated from street drinkers. Beat Managers have also been working with radio users in shops to provide training as part of a CCTV partnership between retailers and services in and around Great Yarmouth town centre.
