Lane Closures at Caister Bypass (A149), Caister-on-Sea

Lane closures will be in place along Caister Bypass (A149) at Caister-on-Sea from Monday 13 November 2023 to Friday 22 December 2023 for the installation of a crash barrier.

The scheme is designed to help address the poor safety record on this busy section of road, which had seen a number of personal injury accidents over recent years.

The work will involve installing a VRS crash barrier along the central reservation of Caister Bypass from the Caister Road Roundabout at Great Yarmouth to the Norwich Road Roundabout at Caister-on Sea.

The road will remain open throughout, however for this work lane closures are required to the fast lane (lane 2) to both the North and South bound carriageway to maintain a safe working area for our subcontractors. Lane 1 will remain open throughout the duration of the works with a reduced speed limit to 40 mph and a signed diversion in place for road users to access West Road, West Caister.

The work which will cost £660,000 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this work is carried out.
